This beautiful campsite in A Guarda/Galicia was completely renovated and modernised in 2017. It has 500 grass-covered pitches with electricity, 8 bungalows, 4 mobile homes, 4 guest rooms. The amenities and services include: restaurant and bar, cafeteria, terrace, sports grounds, swimming pool, games room, play area, supermarket, two sanitary blocks (toilets, showers), clothes washers, areas with dump stations for emptying chemical toilets, telephone, internet and wifi.

Distance from Santa Tecla by car:

Madrid 620 km, Lisbon 423 km, Amsterdam 2,130 km, Paris 1,628 km, Rome 2,400 km, Vienna 2,850 km, London 2,020 km, Berlin 2,660 km, Brussels 1,980 km.

Nearest airports to A Guarda are Vigo (Spain) 65, km Porto (P) 125 km and Santiago (Spain) 110 km.

Nearest rail connections: Vigo (station) 55 km, Porto (station) 120 km and Santiago (station) 125 km


Access to campsite by road: From Tuy to A Guarda on the PO 550. Turn left, after 54 kms, at the traffic lights next to the San Roque church towards Mino River. The campsite is 800m further on and is signposted.

There is a ferry crossing to the town from Caminha (Portugal).

Planned excursions: Monte Santa Tecla and A Guarda (tour of the area) – Cies Island – Santiago de Compostela – El grove, La Toja, Cambados and Ribera Sacra.

Camping/Caravanning/Motorcaravanning

The Netherlands: There were reckoned to be 150,000 motorcaravans in the Netherlands in May this year which means that the number of these vehicles has doubled in the past ten years. Most owners are 56 years and over but even the number of 26 to 35-year-old owners increased by approx. 24% in 2020.

France has over 8,000 campsites and can therefore rightfully claim to have the biggest camping infrastructure in all of Europe.

According to the German liquid gas federation Flüssiggas e.V. (DVFG) **campers in tents should be very careful with camping stoves.** These run on liquid gas, mainly using stick-on or screw-on cartridges. Stick-on cartridges are the cheapest sort and are fixed in place using a pin. The rubber sealant of the appliance prevents the gas from escaping. Stick-on cartridges should only be removed from the appliance when they are completely empty. Anyone wanting to move a tent around from place to place must transport the stove and cartouche together in their assembled state, obviously taking care not to leave it for long in a hot vehicle.

Screw-on cartridges are different because they have a self-closing valve. They can be unscrewed and screwed back on to the stove as often as you like. The same is true for the valve cartridge with its safety bayonet valve.

There is an **maximum limit for loading a motorcaravan** which means that even the weight of the passengers must be taken into account. "Travel light" is a good motto.

When loading up, lightweight luggage and bags should be stowed high up and heavy items low down. Gas bottles should stand upright, secured in their cases and should be removable without having to use tools of any sort. During the journey they must be turned off unless operation of a gas bottle is explicitly permitted.

A small copper coin will help **cut flowers** to stay fresher for longer. Copper produces bacteria that prevents decay.



Hair conditioner for the summer

Yellowing plastic furniture can be treated with baking soda. Mix the baking soda to a paste with water, rub on to the furniture with a cloth and wipe off.

MISCELLANEOUS

Traffic

According to the EU General Safety Regulation, the following assistance systems will become mandatory from 2022/2024:

- ° advanced emergency brake assistant with emergency brake light that warns other vehicles of an emergency braking situation;
- ° lane-keeping assistant;
- ° reversing camera or automatic parking aid;
- ° steering monitoring for driver drowsiness detection and attention warning system;
- ° installation of a standardised interface for an alcohol barrier;
- ° intelligent speed assistant to warn the driver to comply with the statutory speed limit;
- ° and finally an event data recorder (black box) that will register data non-stop such as the accelerator pedal movement, steering behaviour, braking behaviour, gear selection and more besides all of which is automatically deleted after a fixed amount of time, then recording starts again.

There are warnings every year about the dangers of **ticks** and experts are now saying that they are on the increase both in the summer and in the winter. The Robert Koch Institute has seen record numbers of FSME infections from newly-detected species throughout Europe. Many experts are advocating vaccination since ticks are no longer limited to well-defined areas of risk. Sprays containing Icaridin can help keep ticks and mosquitoes away.

28 July is World Hepatitis Day and this in honour of the hepatitis B discoverer Samuel Blumberg. Hepatitis infections cause serious damage to health and damage the liver in particular. There is an appropriate vaccination.

Curious facts/Environment/Culture

Scandinavians, especially Finns, are the **biggest coffee drinkers**. They consume approx 270 litres annually per head of population compared with Germany's 143 litres.



May 20th is **World Bee Day** because the pioneer of modern bee-keeping, the Slovene Anton Jansa, was born on that day. Bee-friendly plants (including lavender) in your garden or on your balcony help these industrious creatures survive and thrive.

Origami originated in Japan and means “folded paper“. This art form goes back to first century China then arrived in Japan, where it reached its peak, and subsequently spread throughout the world.

Stoa 169 is a temple of the arts, an open air gallery in the tradition of a Greek pump room or foyer located in a picturesque meadow in the Pfaffenwinkel of Polling/Bavaria (Germany). It is the brainchild of the artist Bernd Zimmer and consists of a hall with over one hundred columns creatively designed and decorated by different internationally renowned artists. The hall is destined to be a perpetual sign of peaceful co-existence and reconciliation between peoples.

The artists Alex Wreckage and Joe Rush created the monument called “**Mount Trashmore**“ in St. Ives Bay, Cornwall, on the occasion of the G7 Summit in Great Britain. It is a massive sculpture made up of 20,000 pieces of electronic junk. Mount Trashmore portrays the G7 heads of government – along the lines of the American Presidents chiselled in stone at Mount Rushmore in the USA.
