in Russia**

The Russian State Tourism Agency, CARAVANERS LEAGUE and the Suzdal campsite invite you to take part in the “International Festival of Automobile Travelers and Caravaners” GOLDEN RING RALLY 2017 in Suzdal.



The Festival takes place from 24 to 30 July 2017 and will give you the opportunity to find out about the history, architecture and culture of Russia.

A special programme of excursions is being laid on.

Every day at the rally site for the duration of the Festival, there will be:

- Tourism exhibitions of the towns and regions in Russia's Golden Ring
- Displays of souvenirs and national food products
- Russian handicrafts (you can make your own souvenirs)
- Restaurants serving Russian food and drink

A lot of volunteers will be helping out at the Festival offering assistance to participants both at the rally site and during excursions.

This event will be held on a well-equipped campsite with 250 pitches for tents, caravans and motorcaravans.

All participants will receive a Russian visa valid for 1 month.

This is a one-off chance to go to the Festival and to discover the history, culture and traditions of some of Russia's finest towns and cities,.

After booking, all participants will receive a free invitation which is needed when applying for a visa.

All participants will be free to travel elsewhere in Russia for 14 days after the Festival.

Special trips and a special programme of excursions will be arranged for groups to Russia.

There will be opportunities to visit famous cities like Moscow, St. Petersburg, Novgorod, Pskov, Kostroma, Yaroslavl, Rostov Velikiy, Sergiyev Posad, Nizhny Novgorod, Kazan.

The organisers will do their very best to ensure that your journey to the Festival and your excursions and travels around Russia are pleasant, comfortable and safe.

All participants will be given comprehensive information and explanations about service stations, campsites and overnight stopovers (overnight parking areas) in Russia.

Camping/Caravanning/Motorcaravanning

The caravan sector is growing all over Europe with the number of leisure vehicles increasing by nearly 11 percent.

The European market for motorcaravans and caravans performed extremely well again in 2016 clocking up the best results in the sector for seven years. Thus in 2016 a total of 170,064 new leisure vehicles were officially registered across Europe, an impressive increase of 10.6%.

Caravanning is still in vogue throughout Europe. As in previous years, it was the strong German market that boosted the European caravanning sector. With 54,883 newly registered motorcaravans and caravans, Germany chalked up a huge increase of 16.4% compared with the previous year. Great Britain and France are not far behind and together these three countries are the three biggest markets for leisure vehicles in Europe. Last year in the United Kingdom, there were new registrations totalling 35,950 outfits, an increase of 7.1%. The market in France grew by 8.3% with 27,443 new registrations for caravans and motorcaravans.

Basically there was growth in new registrations in virtually all of the European markets. There were impressive gains in Sweden up 22.3% (8,808 leisure vehicles) and in Spain up 14.7% (4,077 leisure vehicles). Thus new registrations of motorcaravans and caravans increased again in the Netherlands (6.9%), Denmark (9.5%) and Italy (6%) and, taken together, outstripped their growth rate in 2015. Results for the motorcaravanning segment are particularly impressive. Compared with 2015, nearly 15,000 more outfits were registered across Europe last year: 96,410 motorcaravans in 2016 represents an increase of 18.3%. Germany came out top with 35,135 registrations of new motorcaravans, up 23.9%.



The number of new motorcaravan registrations in France went up by 13.1% to 19,698 outfits and in Great Britain by 17.3% to around 12,400.

Other important motorcaravanning markets showed amazing gains too. Sweden's registrations rose 31.9% to 5,321 outfits. Last year Spain showed continued strong growth of 37.5% (2,675 outfits). The results of many other markets were still in double figures such as Italy (13.7%) and Belgium (13.6%).

In 2016, the market for caravans in Europe showed stable growth of 1.9% with 73,654 new registrations. The strongest market was in Great Britain that recorded 2.4% growth with 23,550 newly registered caravans. In Germany, 5.1% growth represented 19,748 newly registered caravans. France was the only big market that went into negative territory, down 2.2%. However with 7,745 outfits it still remained the third largest caravan market. The Netherlands was in fourth place, up 5% with 6,078 new caravan registrations.

“Roam like Home” - roaming charges to be abolished this summer.

There will be no more roaming surcharges on mobile phones from 15 June 2017 for people who travel periodically in the EU. The European Parliament and EU member states have agreed on “dismantling” roaming surcharges, clarifying consumer rights and introducing safeguards to ensure the most competitive domestic offers are applied but not abused. Calling, texting and surfing “should” become 90% cheaper.
